As of February 28, 1995, the New Mexico Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB) has not received a Closure Plan for the 300-Pound Moving Trench proposed Closure located at Holloman Air Force Base (HAFB).


Pursuant to telephone conversations between Kathy Giblin of (HAFB) and Charles Lundstrom of my staff we have enclosed a copy of an Administrative Review Checklist for Closure\Postclosure Care Application. This can serve as a helpful tool in the drafting of the closure plan for the 300-Pound Moving Trench closure proposed by HAFB.

Within ten days of receipt of this letter we require a document that describes the closure schedule and activities that will be pursued in the closure of the above mentioned trench. This document must include definite dates as well as a deadline for submittal of the closure plan.
