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RE: Field Sampling at Building 1080 and Hensel Phelps Spill Sites

Dear Mr. Moffitt:

Technical Compliance has reviewed the revised Sampling and Analysis Plans for two JP-4 spill sites at Holloman Air Force Base (HAFB). These spill sites are located at Building 1080 and Hansel Phelps (F-117A) maintenance docks/hangar project.

The technical review indicates HAFB has now provided information which indicates that the proposed confirmatory sampling should be technically adequate. However, technical review emphasized that the confirmatory sampling is to be conducted on soil from bottom depths of the original remedial excavations, not on any backfill material deposited subsequent to the excavations.

Plans and schedules submitted on March 3, 1995, are therefore approved. If there are any changes in the sampling schedule and/or delivery date for the results, I would appreciate being notified. Otherwise, I will be expecting the sampling results as indicated by your March 3, 1995 letter, on March 29, 1995.
