

SUBJECT: 30-day Extension for Holloman AFBs Waste Munitions

1. Headquarters Air Combat Command (ACC) directed each ACC base to close their Thermal Treatment Units and use a regional unit to handle the treatment. ACC's reasoning was to eliminate any permitting fees and reduce the possibility of enforcement actions. Luke Air Force Base (AFB) in Arizona is currently acting as the regional facility for Holloman AFB. Luke AFB currently services 14 Air Force bases.
2. Holloman AFB has a shipment ready to be sent for treatment. However, due to an unusually large shipment from another base, Luke cannot accept Holloman's munitions until the second week in May. This delay causes two items to exceed the 90-day limit, which will expire on 2 May 95.
3. Holloman AFB therefore, requests a 30-day extension on the MF29 Impulse Cartridges, net explosive weight (NEW) of 0.0276 pounds, and the MD47 Delay Cartridges, NEW of 0.0006 pounds.
