Dear Mr. Moffit:

The Technical Compliance staff have evaluated the analytical data for two JP-4 spill sites at Holloman Air Force Base (HAFB). These spill sites are the Building 1080 and Hensel Pheps (F-117A maintenance docks/hangar project sites). The data sets submitted consists of: (1) HAFB's April 5, 1995, letter with attachment, which includes all requested analytical data for soil samples at the original two JP-4 spill sites, and (2) HAFB's April 7, 1995, letter with attachment, which includes all requested analytical data for soil samples from the remediation waste cleanup piles from the two JP-4 spill sites.

Evaluation of the April 5, 1995, analytical data package indicates that there are no hazardous constituents nor hazardous waste concerns at either of the two JP-4 spill sites. The April 7, 1995, analytical data set shows that there are no hazardous constituents nor hazardous waste concerns at either of the two remediation waste cleanup piles from the two JP-4 spill sites. The evaluation of the results indicate that HAFB may dispose of the remediation waste cleanup soils/debris as a solid waste.

HAFB is also to be commended for expediting the necessary site characterizations and soil analyses and fulfilling the technical requests in a timely manner. If you have any further questions regarding this matter, please feel free to call me or Ron Kern at (505) 827-4308.
