

SUBJECT: Extension for Holloman AFB's Notice of Technical Deficiency - - 20,000 Pound
Open Detonation Unit Permit Application (yr 7 Sep 95 ltr)

1. Holloman AFB received the Notice of Technical Deficiency (NOD) from the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) on 14 September 1995. This extensive list is currently being addressed by Holloman AFB and Radian Corporation.
2. In addition to the NOD, Holloman AFB would like to update the items detonated, facility description, frequency of detonation, sampling and closure plans, and personnel training requirements. Holloman AFB would also like to schedule a meeting with the NMED during the first week of November to discuss these anticipated changes. A strategy document will be submitted to the NMED prior to this meeting to explain the desired changes as well as the plan for addressing the NOD.
3. Holloman AFB, therefore, requests a 90-day extension for the NOD corrections as well as the above mentioned changes.
