SUBJECT: 90-day Extension for Holloman AFB Waste Munitions

1. Headquarters Air Combat Command (ACC) directed each ACC base to close their Thermal Treatment Units and use a regional unit to handle the treatment. Luke Air Force Base (AFB) in Arizona is currently acting as the regional facility for Holloman AFB. Luke AFB currently services 14 Air Force bases.
2. Holloman AFB has a shipment ready to be sent for treatment. However, due to the limitations on their Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) permit, Luke AFB cannot accept all the waste munitions at one time. This delay causes one item to exceed the 90-day limit, which will expire on 25 November 1995.
3. Holloman AFB, therefore, requests a 90-day extension for the A165 Cartridges, net explosive weight (NEW) of 482.4 pounds.
