37th Quarterly Progress Report, 1 January 1998-31 March 1998
Civil Engineer Environmental Flight, 49 CES/CEV, 26 March 1998**

The current quarter probably had the lowest level of activity since the signing of the FFCA in 1988. The final cover over Lagoons A-F was completed in the previous quarter. Additionally, the activities associated with effluent management for the new wastewater treatment plant (constructed wetlands) were largely completed in the previous quarter. The major activity remaining is the revegetation of the final cover which will occur in the next two quarters.

8 Jan 98: Submitted 36th Quarterly Progress Report.

3 Mar 98: Foster Wheeler Environmental Corporation sent out bid packages for the revegetation contract. The revegetation work is scheduled to coincide with the normally-occurring period of highest precipitation from June-October.

26 Mar 98: Revegetation contract is awarded to Rocky Mountain Reclamation.
