

**38th Quarterly Progress Report, 1 April 1998-30 June 1998**

30 Mar 98: Submitted 37th Quarterly Progress Report.

23 Apr 98: Received from Radian International the Draft 1998 Sampling Report for the Sewage Lagoons Long-Term Monitoring Program. Monitoring was conducted during January 1998.

5 Jun 98: Received from USEPA Region 6 a Pre-Draft NPDES Permit for the discharge from the new wastewater treatment plant. The new wastewater treatment plant was constructed to allow the lagoons to be taken out of service and closed. An NPDES permit is required because Lake Holloman, Lagoon G and associated jurisdictional wetlands meet the definition of Waters of the US in 40 CFR 122.2.

9 Jun 98: Received from Radian International the Draft Final 1998 Sampling Report for the Sewage Lagoons Long-Term Monitoring Program.

15 Jun-24 Jun 98: Seeding of the lagoons site was completed by Rocky Mountain Reclamation. Seed consisted of a mixture of native grasses and a native shrub, four-wing saltbush. Mulch consisted of 396 bales of certified noxious weed-free hay that was crimped into the soil by disking.
