Dear Brigadier General Lake:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB) has received the Holloman Air Force Base (HAFB) letter dated August 3, 1999 regarding HAFB's 1998 Annual Unit Audit (AUA). HRMB has completed its review of the additional information provided by HAFB concerning removal of various Solid Waste Management Units (SWMU) from its Annual Hazardous Waste Management Business Fee (AHWMBF) assessment.

Following review of the RCRA Facility Assessment Report and the additional Corrective Action documents that you submitted, NMED has determined that the seven alleged SWMUs at the former Primate Research Institute were erroneously included in the original list of SWMUs and permitted units at HAFB. NMED has therefore found the correct number of units to be 116, which include 106 SWMUs, 1 Open Burn Unit, 1 Open Detonation Unit, 1 Container Storage Unit, and 7 Sewage Lagoons. The enclosed worksheet contains a list of the units, and details of how the final amount of the Annual Hazardous Waste Management Business Fee (**the Fee**) of \$41,000.00, was determined.

Payment is due within sixty (60) days of your receipt of this letter. Should the Return Receipt be sent back to us without a date of receipt the fees are due sixty (60) days from the date of this letter. Payment should be made by certified check or money order payable to the New Mexico Environment Department Hazardous Waste Permits Fund 339. Should you need to request an extension of the sixty (60) day period the request must be received by the New Mexico Environment Department a minimum of fourteen (14) calendar days prior to the end of the sixty (60) day period.


