SUBJECT: Request for Extension -- Response to Letter dated 17 Jul 00 Statement of Basis for 70 Solid Waste Management Units

1. In a letter dated 17 Jul 00, the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) requested additional information/clarification in the matter of the Statement of Basis for the 70 Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs) for which Holloman Air Force Base (HAFB) has requested a finding of No Further Action. The deadline for response to the request was sixty days from receipt of the letter.
2. Our office is currently being remodeled. The remodeling has required that files normally kept at hand are currently stored in boxes. The remodeling should be complete by mid to late September and the files returned to a more easily accessible location.
3. This letter is a request for a forty-five (45) day extension to the deadline for the Statement of Basis. The new deadline being 1 Nov 00.
