The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) Hazardous Waste Bureau (HWB) has reviewed Holloman Air Force Base's (HAFB's) request for extension of the deadline for response to the RSI issued by HWB on July 17, 2000 for seventy (70) Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs) and Areas of Concern (AOCs). In your letter dated September 5, 2000, you requested for a forty-five (45) day extension to the deadline because of remodeling work which required that files normally kept at hand be stored in boxes.
