This letter requests Holloman Air Force Base (**HAFB**) to submit the remediation report for the November 5, 2000 JP-4 spill site. I understand that the release, which resulted in a loss of 2,500 gallons of JP-4 fuel was never reported to the New Mexico Environment Department (**NMED**), and no closure report has since then been received at NMED.

Please submit the remediation/closure report to Hazardous Waste Bureau (**HWB**) for review and a final determination on the cleanup.

HWB also wishes to inform HAFB that this Bureau makes final decisions on remediation of sites contaminated with hazardous waste, and not other Bureaus or agencies such as NMED Ground Water Quality Bureau or the Bureau of Land Management.
