The Hazardous Waste Bureau (HWB) of the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received Holloman Air Force Base's Remedial Investigation Final Work Plan dated July 2002 for the above solid waste management unit. HWB has accepted the document for review.

The New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Fee Regulations 20.4.2 NMAC require assessment of fees prior to NMED's review. The fee assessment invoice will be sent to you under separate cover.
