
The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) received Holloman Air Force Base's (HAFB's) December 3, 2002 request for extension of the deadline for response to the notice of deficiency (NOD) on the permit renewal application waste analysis plan (WAP) issued by HWB, dated October 16, 2002. In your letter you explained that HAFB needs a thirty-day extension to allow HAFB to meet with NMED staff, in order to resolve areas of concern, and to ensure that each item detailed in the NOD had been fully and sufficiently addressed.

In light of the above reasons hereby grants HAFB the subject extension. Holloman Air Force Base must therefore submit to HWB the required information not later than thirty (30) calendar days from the date you receive this letter.
