SUBJECT: Solid Waste Management Unit (SWMU) 141-- Request for Supplemental Information (RSI) Response

1. This letter is our formal response to the subject RSI dated 5 Mar 02 and subsequent approved extensions. The RSI was based on the Nov 93 Draft Final Preliminary Assessment and Site Investigation Report, Investigation of Four Waste Sites. Since we do not have funds in the FY03 budget (submitted in Mar 02) to complete the request, Holloman AFB will commit to programming funds within the Department of Defense (DoD) Environmental Restoration Program budget for FY04.
2. SWMU 141 was included in our July 1999 submittal of 104 SWMUs for No Further Action (NFA). We acknowledge that NFA for SWMU 141 was not accepted by the New Mexico Environment Department; however, the requested information will require a Remedial Investigation (RI). Since we did not anticipate the need to program funds for an RI at SWMU 141 for an FY03, no funds will be available to complete this project in FY03. We will program funds for a RI project at SWMU 141 in FY04. Please realize, however, that all DoD restoration projects compete for limited dollars available in a particular year and projects may not receive funds despite a clear need.
