No Further Action Approved Determinations

Holloman AFB hereby notifies you that is initiating a Class III modification for the designation of seven (7) solid waste management units (SWMUs) and areas of concern (AOC) as "approved for No Further Action" (NFA) in Table B of the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments (HSWA) Module (Module IV) of the Resource Conservation and Recovery (RCRA) Permit for Holloman Air Force Base (EPA ID No. NM6572124422).

For each SWMU or AOC, the rationale for NFA designation has been documented in either a NFA proposal (for SWMUs) or SWMU Assessment Report (for AOCs). The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has reviewed the NFA proposals and SWMU Assessment Reports and the NMED has determined that each SWMU/AOC is appropriate for NFA.

HAFB requests that the seven (7) SWMU/AOCs in Table A of the HSWA Module be designated as no further action (Corrective Action Complete). When comprehensive changes are made to the HSWA Module, two new tables (Table A SWMUs Requiring Corrective Action and Table B SWMUs Not Requiring Corrective Action) will be added to the HSWA Module.

COMMENT PERIOD:

A 60-day public comment period has been initiated with the publication of this notice. Comments on this request for permit modification will be accepted through June 1, 2005.
