Dear Ms. Hartell:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has reviewed for technical completeness the Holloman Air Force Base (HAFB) revised Statement of Basis (SOB) for the above-referenced sites, and the proposal by HAFB that those sites be considered for no further action (NFA). The SOB, which describes the seven (7) solid waste management units (SWMUs) and areas of concern (AOCs) was dated November 2004.

Pursuant to its authority under the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Act, N.M.S.A. 74-4-1 et seq., and regulations promulgated pursuant thereto, the HWB has determined that the subject document is administratively complete, and that the six SWMUs and one AOC appear appropriate for NFA status. The Table below contains a description of the seven sites that NMED has deemed appropriate for NFA.

SWMU -166	MOBSS Drainage Lagoon

SWMU -106	Main Base Landfill
SWMU -DP-62	Rita's Draw Debris Disposal Site
SWMU -136	Building 1119 Wash Rack Drainage Pit


* The site is considered appropriate for NFA, although it never underwent investigation by the Hazardous Waste Bureau. The site is therefore being NFA'd administratively, and would be turned over to the NMED Solid Waste Bureau for any future regulatory action.

The New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Fee Regulations 20.4.2 NMAC require assessment of fees when administrative review of a document is complete. HWB will issue an invoice under a separate letter.

Payment is due within 60 days from the day you receive the invoice. Should you request an extension of the sixty-day period, the request must be received by NMED within a minimum of fourteen (14) calendar days prior to the end of the sixty-day period. Should you disagree with the fee assessed you may file an Administrative Appeal under the provisions of 20.4.2.302.1 NMAC.
