The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) Hazardous Waste Bureau (HWB) has reviewed Holloman Air Force Base's (HAFB's) September 13, 2005 request (signed by A. David Budak, Deputy Base Engineer) for extension of the deadline to meet additional investigation requirements at Sites FT-31 (SWMU-135) and AOC-2.

In your letter, you explained that HAFB is requesting the extension of the deadline for submittal of your response to NMED's request for supplemental information (RSI) for the subject sites in order to collect and analyze groundwater samples at both FT-31 and AOC-2, as requested in the RSI of February, 2005.

Based upon the above reason, NMED hereby grants the 90-day extension for submittal of the response to the RSIs for investigation of the subject sites. Holloman Air Force Base shall therefore submit the response to the RSIs to NMED not later than December 27, 2005.
