Dear Ms. Hartell:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has completed review of Holloman Air Force Bases's (the Permittee's) November 18, 2005 Revised Final RCRA Facility Investigation (RFI) Report for Area of Concern (AOC) 2. The Permittee submitted this revised RFI Report in response to NMED's Request for Supplemental Information (RSI), dated July 25, 2005. This RSI was issued after review of the initial RFI Report dated February 2005.

Based on NMED's review of this response, it has been determined that AOC-2 appears to be suitable for a No Further Action (NFA) petition. Therefore, the Permittee may propose this site for NFA based on NMED's NFA Criterion 5, which states, "*The AOC has been characterized and/or remediated in accordance with current applicable state or federal regulations, and the available data indicate that contaminants pose an acceptable level of risk under current and projected future land use.*"
