The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has reviewed Holloman Air Force Base's (the Permittee's) June 21, 2006 request (signed by A. David Budak) for a 90-day extension of the deadline to meet additional investigation requirements at Site DP-64 (AOC-1).


