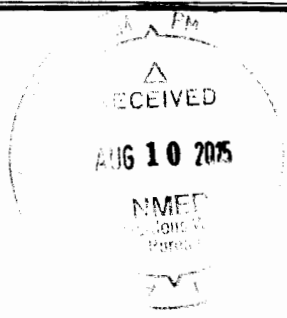

# **PUBLIC NOTICE**

## **Discharge Permit Application**

### **Holloman Air Force Base, DP-1479**

DP-1479, Holloman Air Force Base, Adam M. Kusmak, 49 CES/CEI Chief, proposes to renew and modify the Discharge Permit for the discharge of up to 99,999 cubic yards per day of petroleum contaminated soil onto a land application area. The proposed modification consists of remediating the contaminated soil to the applicable New Mexico Industrial/Occupational Soil Screening Levels rather than to the applicable criteria for New Mexico Residential Soil and returning the thus remediated soil to the site from which it was extracted. Potential contaminants from this type of discharge include organic compounds. The facility is located at Holloman Air Force Base, approximately 10 miles west of Alamogordo, in Section 14, T17S, R08E, Otero County. Ground water beneath the site is at a depth of approximately 10 - 18 feet and has a total dissolved solids concentration of approximately 16,000 milligrams per liter.

The applicant is seeking a Discharge Permit for the proposed discharge. Provided the applicant has met applicable requirements, the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) will propose a Discharge Permit containing limitations, monitoring requirements, and other conditions intended to protect ground water quality for present and potential future use. Information in this public notice was provided by the applicant and will be verified by the New Mexico Environment Department during the permit application review process. NMED will accept comments and statements of interest regarding the application and will create a facility specific mailing list for persons who wish to receive future notices.
