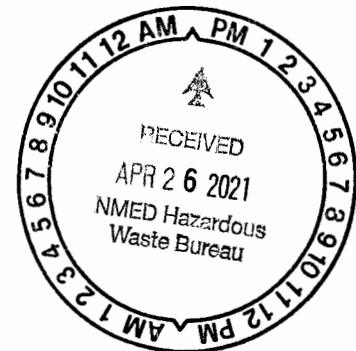

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) requested in their July 2, 2020 letter, *Approval, Final Fiscal Year 2019 Groundwater Monitoring Report SS018 – VOC Spill Site (AOC H) October 2019* that submission of the Fiscal Year (FY) 2020 Long-Term Monitoring (LTM) Report was due to NMED by December 31, 2020.
