
The New Mexico Environmental Improvement Division (EID) has received from Kirtland Air Force Base (KAFB) the documents required prior to operation of the hazardous waste storage unit, Building 1024. Mr. David Englert from EID's Hazardous Waste Permitting Section also toured the facility on November 9, 1990. Based upon EID's review of these documents and the results of the tour, EID has determined that KAFB may begin to store hazardous waste at the Hazardous Waste Storage Unit, Building 1024, as described in the KAFB Hazardous Waste Storage Permit, after the following permit conditions are met:

- (1) Warning Signs with the legend, "Danger - Unauthorized Personnel Keep Out," will be posted at the entrances to and on all other sides of the Hazardous Waste Storage Unit. These signs will be visible from 25 feet and will be printed in English and Spanish. [Permit Attachment II-3, D-1a(3)]
- (2) The emergency equipment stored in the hazardous waste facility consisting of overpack drums and absorbent, brooms, shovels, and protective gear, clothes, radios, and extinguishers, will be supplied at the facility. [Permit Attachment II-7, G-5]
