L-1c. Training Director 40 CFR Section 264.16(a)(2)

The training director in charge of the DRMS Environmental Training Program shall be trained in hazardous waste management procedures. The training program must include instruction which teaches facility personnel hazardous waste management procedures, including contingency plan implementation, relevant to the positions in which they are employed.

L-1(c)(1) Training of generation and Satellite Accumulation Point Personnel

Kirtland personnel at generation points and satellite accumulation points will receive sufficient training to enable them to perform their duties in a manner that ensures Kirtland's compliance with the requirements of this permit. This training program will be conducted by a person trained in hazardous waste management procedures and will include an explanation of DRMO functions and information requirements.

All personnel at generator and satellite accumulation points, including supervisors, will receive the training in Exhibit L-9\* and this training will be reviewed annually. Changes in the Generator/Satellite Accumulation Point Outline that affect the type or decrease the amount of training will require a minor permit modification according to 40 CFR Section 270.42.

\* The outline KAFB proposed will become the new Exhibit L-9.
