RE: Flare testing protocols at Elephant Butte Lake


Dear Mr. Bratton:

Enclosed is Kirtland Air Force Base's (KAFB) final determination and statement of measures taken to resolve any existing problems at the referenced site.

The Hazardous and Radioactive Waste Bureau (HRWB) has advised KAFB to work with the Park Service to build a fenced area within which to locate the conex such that public access to the conex will be eliminated. The forming of such an agreement is solely between KAFB and the Park Service.

Item 4 of the attached letter states that KAFB is seeking permission to cease use of live flares. HRWB has encouraged KAFB to pursue this course.
