Dear Colonel Norris:

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) approves your request for an emergency permit for Kirtland's Explosive Ordnance Detachment (EOD) to provide emergency assistance in detonating three cases of crystallized dynamite at the request of Laguna Pueblo. This situation meets the requirements of 40 CFR §270.61 being an imminent and substantial endangerment to human health and the environment. EPA requests that you determine that there is no residual material remaining after proper disposal of the dynamite, and any residual material will be properly disposed.
