

The Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB) of the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) is in receipt of Kirtland AFB's document entitled: "No Further Action Document Site SD-27 Tijeras Arroyo Golf Course Kirtland AFB, New Mexico" which, together with the signed certifications received March 29, 1993, constitutes the certification of clean closure for the golf course unit. HRMB has reviewed the sampling and analysis results from the sampling program conducted in 1989 and concurs that no hazardous constituents are present at the unit above regulatory concern. HRMB agrees that the investigations conducted at the unit were in accordance with the approved closure plan and hereby grants clean closure and terminates interim status for the golf course unit.
