**Re: Due Date for Closure Certification Report, Base Sewage
Lagoons and Golf Course Main Pond**

Dear Colonel Norris:

The Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB) of the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) is in receipt of the sample analysis results dated June 14, 1993 for Kirtland Air Force Base (KAFB) Golf Course Main Pond and the Base Sewage Lagoons. Receipt of this data is hereby considered documentation for completion of field activities required by the approved closure plans for the aforementioned units.

Pursuant to the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (HWMR-7) Part VI, 40 CFR 265.115, KAFB must now submit to NMED a certification of closure with supporting documentation no later than August 13, 1993 (60 days after completion of closure activities). The closure certification report must include the details of any variance from the approved closure plans and the reason for the variance, as well as a certification that the report is accurate and complete.

In order to demonstrate that there have been no impacts above Health-Based Action Levels to the groundwater from these closing units, KAFB must submit any and all groundwater quality data pertinent to monitoring wells 0501, 0502, 0503, 0504, 0602, 0608, 0609, and 0610 from December 1990 to present. If there are any other data collected in conjunction with this closure that KAFB wants to be considered in NMED's decision of whether or not to grant clean closure of these units, it must be provided with the


