Dear Ms Hoditschek,

Thank you for allowing Kirtland Air Force Base (KAFB) personnel to meet with you and your staff on 8 October 1993 to discuss post closure plans and activities for the Sewage Lagoons and Golf Course Main Pond regulated units at KAFB. As a result of this meeting, KAFB personnel are now aware of what is required for post-closure by the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) under the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (HWMR-7), Part VI, 40 CFR Sections 265.117 - 265.120.

Although KAFB still maintains that all requirements for clean closure of these units have been met, we will submit a written post-closure plan as we agreed at the meeting.

At this time, I would like to formally request that the required submittal date for the post-closure plan be extended to 8 January 1994, which is 90 days after the 8 October 1993 meeting. Currently, the required date of submittal is 90 days after receipt of NMED's clean closure denial letter dated 27 September 1993.


