Dear Steve,

I received a copy of your letter dated 3 November 1993 and reviewed the original ENESCO lab reports for the Golf Course Main Pond and Sewage Lagoons. You are correct in stating that many of the results I was referring to were trip blanks, equipment blanks, etc. My previous information listed sample numbers that appeared to be sequential with the actual environmental samples, and I assumed they were duplicates.

The tabulated results included in your letter are correct; the Kirtland Air Force Base (KAFB) EM Division agrees with these results. The table is an accurate compilation of all chromium (total) test results of samples from the eight monitor wells at these units between May 1990 and May 1992.
