



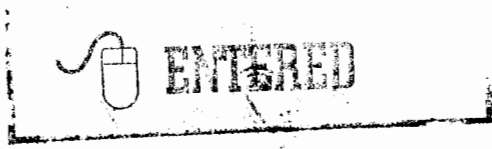

The EPA Region VI RCRIS report shows three violations at Kirtland Air Force Base which have been closed out by the State of New Mexico:

A Class I violation (#S0024) and two Class II violations (#S003 and #S0004) were all included in a Compliance Agreement issued by NMEID February 28, 1990. In a letter dated August 29, 1991, NMED indicated that all terms of the February 1990 Compliance Agreement had been satisfied.

The RCRIS report should reflect an actual return to compliance date of August 29, 1991 for the three violations (S0024, S0003 and S004). We request the report be updated as such.
