**RE: Public Notice of Proposed Post-closure Plan, Sewage Lagoons  
and Golf Course Main Pond**

On April 6, 1994, the Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB) received the final post-closure plan for Kirtland Air Force Base sewage lagoons and golf course main pond dated April 1, 1994. The HRMB review of the document submitted indicates that it meets the substance of the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (HWMR-7), Part VI, Section 40 CFR 265.118.

The HRMB is issuing a thirty (30) day public comment period in accordance with HWMR-7, Part VI, Section 40 CFR 265.118(f) on the proposed post-closure plan. You are invited to comment on the plan during the public comment period running from May 12 through June 13, 1994. The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) will reach a final decision on the post-closure plan approval at the end of the public comment period. All comments received by the end of the public comment period will be considered in the NMED's final decision.
