RE: **Comprehensive Groundwater Monitoring Evaluation at the Sewage Lagoons and Golf Course Main Pond**


This letter is to confirm the June 10, 1994 telephone conversation between yourself and Ron Kern of the Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB). It was agreed verbally that HRMB would conduct a Comprehensive Groundwater Monitoring Evaluation (CME) at the Sewage Lagoons (SLs) and Golf Course Main Pond (GCMP) at Kirtland Air Force Base's (KAFB) next scheduled groundwater sampling event for these units. HRMB understands that this event is tentatively scheduled for June 28 and/or June 29, 1994.

For the purpose of this CME, HRMB proposes to split groundwater samples with KAFB from monitoring wells at the SLs (monitoring wells 0501, 0502, 0503, and 0504) and possibly the GCMP (monitoring wells 0602, 0608, 0609, and 0610). HRMB would furnish its own sample containers and blanks and would provide for sample preservation, transportation, and analysis of all samples acquired by HRMB.

HRMB would appreciate the opportunity to split groundwater samples with KAFB's Environmental Group from the selected monitoring wells at these RCRA units. If KAFB is agreeable to the proposed sampling schedule, please inform HRMB at your earliest convenience.
