RE: Class I Modification for Storage Facilities

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB) has completed review of Kirtland Air Force Base's (KAFB) request for Class I permit Modification. You indicated in both your letters of January 5, 1994 and June 15, 1994 that the only changes you wished to effect were from Extraction Procedures (EP) Toxicity Hazardous Waste Codes to Toxicity Characteristics Leaching Procedures (TCLP) Hazardous Waste Codes, for the TCLP Waste Codes D018 through D043. This is requested because the permit was issued prior to promulgation of the TCLP regulation which replaced the EP Toxicity characteristics. This modification is needed in order to be consistent with the toxicity characteristic codes of the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (HWMR-7), 40 CFR, Part II, Section 261. NMED understands that KAFB is not seeking a change in waste inventory or storage limits.

Based upon the above information which KAFB supplied to HRMB, NMED hereby approves of the Class I permit modification for KAFB. The effective date of the approval is your date of receipt of this letter. These changes are shown on the attached pages, that is, page 1 of the enclosure, which KAFB submitted on June 15, 1994 shall now replace page 2 of the enclosure which was taken





from the KAFB Storage Permit. These changes are incorporated into the KAFB Storage Permit EPA ID #: NM9570024423-1. You are required to incorporate the enclosed copies in KAFB's copy of the Storage Permit formerly issued by NMED.

Further, KAFB is required to send a notice of the modification to all persons on the facility mailing list which is enclosed herein. This notification must be made within 90 calendar days after the change is put into effect in compliance with HWMR-7, Part IX, 40 CFR §270.42(a)(ii).
