This is to acknowledge receipt of your letter of August 31, 1994. Your suggestion of the change in verbiage in KAFB's draft Permit Condition II.B.I. is acceptable, hence the following changes have been effected in Module II, Permit Condition B.I., with the redundant word struck out; while the added words are shown highlighted, thus:

II.B.I The ~~manufacturer~~ **generator** of the explosive ~~waste~~ shall provide the Permittee Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) ~~or equivalent technical information~~ that contain all the chemical composition (and percentages) required by this permit. The Permittee shall review....

The above modification has been incorporated into the subject draft permit. NMED anticipates your letter within 15 days of your receipt of this letter, stating that you are withdrawing your earlier request for a public hearing.
