Attached is our notice to U.S. EPA Region 6 of a Class I modification to the Kirtland AFB Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Hazardous and Solid Waste Act (HSWA) Permit. A Class I modification allows the base to add or move sites in the permit without public hearing.

During a files review in June 1994, the Restoration Branch found a letter that indicated testing was done to prepare for landscaping around Building 20451; test results showed that herbicides were used around this building. A review of building records and conversations with long-time EM employees indicated it was used by the U.S. Army as a laundry facility. We immediately notified the EPA and sent a SWMU assessment report to them in August 1994. In September 1994, the EPA notified us that they had determined the building was, in fact, a SWMU and directed us to add it to our permit.

This letter constitutes a Notice of Class I Modification to the Kirtland Air Force Base HWSA RCRA Permit Part B.

In June 1994, we notified Ms. Morlock of a possible SWMU at Building 20451, a former U.S. Army laundry facility, with suspected dry-cleaning activities. In August 1994, we forwarded our SWMU assessment report. In a letter dated 28 September 1994, your office determined this building was, in fact, a SWMU and directed us to add it to our permit under Appendix V.
