RE: Request for Extension of Ground Water Sampling Period

Dear Mr. DeWitt:

We have received your letter requesting an extension by One Quarter, for the fourth quarterly Post Closure Ground Water (GW) Monitoring report that is due by June 30, 1995. The report is for the Sewage Lagoons and Golf Course Main Pond (SL & GCMP), Kirtland Air Force Base.

We at the New Mexico Environment Department, Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB) understand that the report was delayed due to problems you encountered during contract modifications. We also understand that you had planned to begin the third round of ground water sampling at the SL and GCMP during the week of January 30-February 3, 1995.

Based on the above explanation and your plans to continue the ground water sampling, HRMB hereby grants you the requested extension from April 1 through June 30, 1995. We must therefore receive the fourth quarterly GW monitoring report from you **not later than June 30, 1995.**
