Dear Ms. Morlock

This letter is to notify you of a potential SWMU, a previously undocumented oil/water separator and injection well at Building 980. This building, formerly operated as a fire station, now serves as the Base Civil Engineers' west-side maintenance operation center.

The OWS previously received wastewater from a vehicle wash rack and possibly building floor drains. It is now abandoned and disconnected from any influent source. The injection well is connected to the separator by a 2-inch oil draw-off line. Plumbing configurations noted in building drawings lead us to believe floating petroleum, oil, and lubricant (POL) products and water were likely discharged from the OWS to the well.

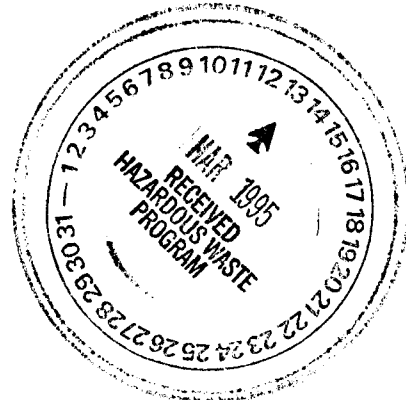
We will submit a SWMU Assessment Report to your office within 90 days of the date of this letter (5 June 1995).
