NOTICE OF INTENT TO PERMIT AN OPEN BURNING TREATMENT UNIT

The State of New Mexico is authorized to operate a hazardous waste management program in lieu of the Federal program for those portions of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) in effect prior to the enactment of the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments of 1984 (HSWA). The HSWA impose additional requirements on hazardous waste management facilities which will be administrated by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) until the State of New Mexico receives additional authorization for those requirements.

Under authority of the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Act NMSA 1978 §74-4-1 et. seq. (Repl.Pamp. 1993) as amended, 1989, and the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations [20 NMAC 4.1(Effective September 23, 1994)], the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) can approve or deny permit applications. NMED has received a permit application submitted by the **Department of Defense(DOD)/Kirtland Air Force Base(KAFB), EPA I.D. Number NM9570042243-OB,,** for an Open Burning Treatment Unit.

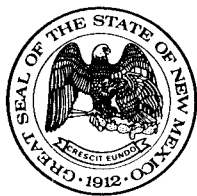

An informal public meeting is scheduled for Thursday, April 20, 1995, from 6:30 p.m. until 8:30 p.m. at the Kirtland Air Force Base Wing Conference Center, Building 20604. The building is located on Wyoming Boulevard, about 2 miles south of Central Avenue, at the intersection with M Street on the east side, opposite the National Atomic Museum. At this meeting, a HRMB staff member will be available to provide the public with additional information on the proposed permit. Everyone is invited to attend this informational meeting. All interested members of the public who wish to drive to attend this meeting are required to have a valid driver's license and proof of vehicle insurance for each driver of each vehicle entering KAFB premises, in order to be allowed entrance to the KAFB by the Base security personnel. Access to the KAFB meeting auditorium is also possible by Suntran buses, for those who might choose this option.

Any person who wishes to comment upon the draft permit or to request a public hearing should submit written comments and requests, along with the commentor's name and address, to the Santa Fe address. Requests for a public hearing shall state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing and the name and address of the commenter. Only comments and/or requests received by **May 29, 1995** will be considered. NMED will provide a thirty (30) day notice of a public hearing, if scheduled.

NMED must ensure that the approved draft permit is consistent with the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations for permits. All written comments submitted on the draft permit will be considered in formulating a final decision. NMED will notify KAFB and each person who submitted a written comment during the public comment period of the final decision.

After consideration of all written comments received, NMED will approve, or modify and approve the draft permit. If NMED modifies and approves the draft permit, then NMED shall provide KAFB with a detailed written statement of reasons for the modification and the modified draft permit will become the approved permit. A copy of the modified permit with a detailed statement of the reasons for the modifications will be mailed to KAFB.

DRAFT OPEN BURNING PERMIT
FACT SHEET

for the

KIRTLAND AIR FORCE BASE

OPEN BURNING UNIT

ALBUQUERQUE, NEW MEXICO

Activities: Open Burning thermal treatment (destruction) of waste munitions at the Department of Defense/Kirtland Air Force Base (KAFB) under the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Act.

Facility Name: U.S. Department of Defense
Kirtland Air Force Base

EPA I.D. No.: NM9570024423-OB

Location: The KAFB facility is located in Bernalillo County, southeast of the Manzano Base, northcentral New Mexico, 10 miles (16 km) from the southern perimeter of KAFB.

Unit Purpose: The objective of the work to be conducted under this Permit is to thermally treat reactive wastes in the form of bulk explosives, damaged, defective, or expired munitions, and rags contaminated with waste explosives.

Unit Description: The Open Burn (OB) range is located in a cleared area 3750 feet (1143 meters) in diameter. The area is surrounded by a three-strand barbed wire fence. On the eastern half of the cleared area is the burn pit that is 30.5 feet (9.2 meters) long, 10.5 feet (3.2 meters) wide and 8 feet (2.4 meters)

deep. KAFB plans to open burn up to 80,000 pounds (36,281 kilograms) of waste munitions per calendar year at the OB treatment unit.

Requests for hearing should include a statement of the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing and must include the requestor's name and address. Only comments and requests for hearing received by **May 29, 1995** will be considered. The NMED will publish a thirty day (30) notice of a public hearing, if scheduled.

**Final
Decision:**

All comments received on the draft Permit during the public comment period will be considered in reaching a final Permit approval decision. The NMED will notify KAFB and each person who submitted a written comment, of any changes made in finalizing the Permit.
