Enclosed is a copy of the draft Open Burn permit prepared by the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED). NMED will publish a legal notice that a draft permit has been prepared on April 14, 1995, and will allow 45 days for review and public comment, including requests for public hearing. KAFB will be notified by certified mail if a public hearing is scheduled. NMED also plans to hold an informal meeting to discuss the draft permit with all interested parties on Thursday April 20, 1995 from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. at the Base Wing Conference Center, in auditorium 20604, located at KAFB.

NMED will give due consideration and the weight it deems appropriate to all comments received during the public comment period. When ruling on permit issuance, NMED may make reasonable conditions to the permit to meet the requirements of the Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (20 NMAC 4.1). At the time that any final permit decision is issued, NMED will issue a response to comments. The final permit decision shall become effective as of the date of signature of the Secretary of the New Mexico Environment Department. The approved permit will be transmitted to KAFB by certified mail.
