Dear Ms. Morlock

As you requested, I am enclosing our "interpretation" of the appendices in our RCRA Part B Permit. Along with verifying SWMUs within each appendix, I also made some much-needed corrections to the SWMU descriptions.

We will soon request a modification to our RCRA Part B Permit to re-establish Appendices I, II, and III in Module IV. Corrective action schedules for each appendix will be based upon the relative risk of the sites within that appendix:

- a. We plan to place all *high* relative risk sites into Appendix I. Existing Appendix I high relative risk sites will follow the current corrective action schedule; corrective actions on new and transferred Appendix I sites will be accelerated to match the current schedule.
- b. Corrective action activities at Appendix II, *medium* relative risk, sites will begin only after all corrective measures implementations (final remedial actions) are in place at Appendix I sites.
- c. Corrective action activities at Appendix III, *low* relative risk, sites will begin only after all corrective measures implementations are in place at Appendix II sites.

We will continue to place potential radioactive and or mixed waste sites into Appendix IV, with individual corrective action schedules.

We will continue to budget for activities at medium and low relative risk sites on a yearly basis; these projects may be funded if sufficient moneys are allocated from the command. However, if funds are shortfalled, high relative risk sites will be under a regulatory compliance schedule and, therefore, will be funded first. Ultimately, the goal is to channel available funds to high relative risk sites, while meeting regulatory requirements.

When I have restructured the appendices, I will forward the permit modification proposal to you. As a reminder, most of the SWMUs in Appendices II and III are not on the IRP. We intend to add to the IRP only those SWMUs where releases were identified in their respective RFIs.
