Attached is our notice to U.S. EPA Region 6 of a Class I modification to the Kirtland AFB RCRA Part B Permit. A Class I modification allows the base to add or move sites in the permit without public hearing.

In mid-April 1995, we notified the EPA of two potential Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs), a former skeet range and a former pistol range. In July 1995, we presented our SWMU Assessment Report to the EPA, in which, based on initial test results, we recommended only the former pistol range be added as a SWMU.

In their 6 December 1995 letter (attached), the EPA agreed with our assessment, and directed us to add the former pistol range to the permit. Due to recent procedural changes agreed to by the EPA, we will add the range as OT-74 once the RCRA Facility Investigation is completed, the report issued, and a relative risk evaluation completed.

This letter constitutes a Notice of Class I Modification to the Kirtland Air Force Base RCRA Part B Permit.

In an 11 April 1995 letter, we notified your office of two potential SWMUs, a former skeet range and a former pistol range. In our 11 July 1995 letter, we forwarded our SWMU Assessment Report. In this letter, we advised EPA that we believed only the former pistol range qualified as a SWMU.

We will assign this site, SWMU OT-74, to an appendix in Module IV of the RCRA Part B Permit when the RFI Report is finalized and a relative risk evaluation completed.
