The New Mexico Environment Department (**NMED**) Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (**HRMB**) received Kirtland Air Force Base's (**KAFB**) request for Class II Training Requirements Permit Modification. You indicated in your letter of January 19, 1996, that you wished to make the changes in regulatory language to correspond to satellite accumulation regulations contained in 20 NMAC 4.1, Subpart V 40 CFR §264.34 (c), which do not identify any training requirements.

The New Mexico Hazardous Waste Fee Regulations (**NMAC 4.2**) require the assessment of permit fees for permit modifications. Permit modifications classified as major (Class II) by the Hazardous Waste Management Regulations [20 NMAC 4.1, Subpart IX, 40 CFR §270.42 (b), §270, Appendix I], require extensive staff time and administrative effort to review the impact of the modifications on the permit. The Class II Modification to amend the Container Storage Training Requirements is subject to a fee of \$15,000.00.


