Dear Mr. Lanz:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has reviewed the above-referenced document and has considered comments received from Kirtland Air Force Base during a meeting on May 23, 2006. Based on staff review, NMED hereby withdraws the requirement to collect samples for semi-volatiles analysis and issues this revision of its earlier notice of approval with modifications, dated May 2, 2006, of the Voluntary Corrective Measures Work Plan for SWMU WP-26:

Kirtland Air Force Base (KAFB) shall collect soil samples from the depth interval 6 to 12 inches from the 6 proposed perimeter boring locations (*i.e.*, 2671, 2672, 2673, 2674, 2675, and 2676), and from 12 proposed berm boring locations (*i.e.*, 2657, 2658, 2659, 2660, 2661, 2662, 2663, 2664, 2665, 2666, 2667, and 2668) for analysis of eight RCRA metals (*e.g.*, arsenic, barium, cadmium, chromium, lead, mercury, selenium, and silver).


