The New Mexico Environment Department Hazardous Waste Bureau has received your April 17, 2007, request for an extension to Kirtland Air Force Base's responses to the subject Notice of Deficiency (NOD). On February 7, 2007, NMED approved KAFB's request to combine the results of the subject work plans into one report.

The original due date for the combined report was March 6, 2007. NMED had previously given a verbal approval for a 56-day time extension until May 1, 2007. In this letter NMED approves an additional 92 day extension: a total time extension of 148 days is hereby granted. The new due date is August 1, 2007.


