As we discussed, during January 2009, we conducted a monitoring event of all of the groundwater monitor wells installed to date as part of the Bulk Fuels project that did not contain PSH, and three water production wells on KAFB. We anticipate the validated results to be received by the first week of March, at which time we will contact you to review and evaluate the results and determine the location for the three monitor wells that are currently funded (one from our FY08 project, and we received funding for the FY09 project which had proposed installation of 2 additional monitor wells). We have not collected a water sample from the VA Hospital well as the well is out of operation for repairs, upon repair we will collect a sample for analyses.

Additionally, the FY09 projects included funding for two additional SVE units which will be received and installed during the next four to five months. Installation will be discussed with you to ensure approval of the locations. Again, these SVE units are considered as interim systems and not the final abatement option.

We are also establishing a Citizens Advisory Board for the Bulk Fuels Facility project, which will meet later this month.
