

Pursuant to the provisions of the Defense Environmental Restoration Program (10 USC Part 160, *Environmental Restoration*), which was established with passage of the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act (SARA) of 1986, Kirtland Air Force Base (KAFB) has conducted preliminary assessments and site inspections of Military Munitions Response Program (MMRP) sites within the confines of the installation.

Kirtland AFB's restoration personnel have recently completed an Abbreviated Remedial Investigation for MMRP sites TS775 and TS776. As required by 10 USC §2710(c)(2), E.O. 12580, EO 13016 and OSWER Directive 9200.3-60, I am submitting KAFB's Final Abbreviated Remedial Investigation Report for Military Munitions Response Program Sites TS775 and TS776 Skeet Ranges for your review, comment, and/or records retention.

As we continue to implement the provisions of DERP and the SARA amendments to complete the identification, investigation and cleanup of contamination within KAFB, we look forward to your input on accomplishing these goals.
