Good afternoon Mr. Kieling, et al,

The KAFB BFF CATOX SVE System was shut down for routine maintenance on Monday 9/22. When the CB&I technicians tried to restart the system, it would not start. The vender Anguil, had their engineer on site Tuesday 9/23 to trouble shoot the system and found that the source of the problem was the igniter. The igniter has been ordered by Anguil and the part and an Anguil technician are expected on site by Thursday 9/25 for the repair. The repair is expected to be performed Thursday afternoon through Friday. Status of the repair will be provided by Friday COB.

Side note: 3rd Quarter Stack testing, an AEHD requirement (20.11.65 NMAC VOC testing, under Permit #3036-EP), was scheduled to be performed today Wednesday 9/24. Due to the necessary repairs above, KAFB formally requested an extension of AEHD, today. The new stack test date will be formulated once the repairs are made.
