Since we received NMED approval for pH adjustment of treated groundwater today, we plan to proceed with the schedule below for operation of the Temporary Treatment System and the Full-Scale GWTS:

- 12/15: Disconnect of the TTS from KAFB-106228 and drain water lines to prevent freezing. Start shutdown of TTS to prepare for demobilization. Treated development water from wells KAFB-106233 and 106234 currently being held in tanks at the TTS will be discharged once analytical results are received over the next few days.
- 12/16: Connect GWTS to KAFB-106228, treat and sample up to 5,000 gallons of groundwater with 24-hour TAT, hold water until results are returned

- 12/17: Laboratory receives and begins analyzing treated KAFB-106228 sample
- 12/18: Receive sample results, if clean, verify pH is below discharge limit, and discharge to golf course main pond
- 12/21 – 12/23: Begin manual operation of the GWTS during daylight hours, and begin testing and commissioning of automated operation
- 12/24 – 12/27: Shut-down for holiday
- Week of 12/28: Continue system commissioning and begin continuous 24/7 operation of GWTS with discharge to golf course main pond. There may be intermittent shut-down periods due to the installation of isolation valves and other modifications to the Well 7 pipeline during this week.
