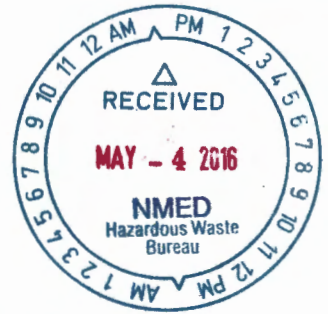

Pursuant to the provisions of the Defense Environmental Restoration Program (DERP), (10 USC Chapter 160, *Environmental Restoration*) Kirtland Air Force Base (KAFB) has conducted preliminary assessments and site inspections of the Military Munitions Response Program (MMRP) sites within the boundary of the installation.

KAFB's restoration personnel have recently completed the Engineering Evaluation/ Cost Analysis (EE/CA) Report for MMRP sites AL120a Propellant Dispersal Site, AL120b McCormick UXO, and TG100 Bomb Target Area Munitions Response Sites (MRSs). As required by 10 USC §2710(c)(2), E.O. 12580, E.O. 13016 and Office of Solid Waste and Emergency Response Directive 9200.3-60, I am submitting the EE/CA Report for MMRP sites AL120a, AL120b, and TG100 for your review, comment, and records retention.

As we continue to implement the provisions of DERP and the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act to complete the identification, investigation and cleanup of contamination within KAFB, we look forward to your input on accomplishing these goals.
